

AW PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT



We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. As a player, you have a big part to play. That's why The FA is asking every player to follow a Respect Code of Conduct. When playing football, I will:

- Always play to the best of my ability
- Play fairly – I won't cheat, complain or waste time
- Respect all players taking part and the coaches
- Play by the laws, when appropriate as directed by the referee
- After fixtures I will shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game
- Listen and respond to what my coach tells me
- Talk to someone I trust or the welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything I understand that if I do not follow the code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by the Academy, County FA or The FA I May:
 - Be required to apologise to my team mates, the other team, referee or team manager
 - Receive a formal warning from the coach
 - Be dropped or substituted
 - Be suspended from training
 - Be required to leave the Academy In Addition:
 - My Academy, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct
 - The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my Club/Soccer School
